  - \* Application for general / international student admission(1st Round) is compulsory.

Graduated or expected to graduate in Feb. 2020 and scheduled to enter Ph.D program in Mar. 2020 [Ph.D type 2]



- 2 Reference letter(from the dean / full-time faculty of the department one is applying for)
- 3 Academic performance
  - Master's / Combined Master's & Ph.D Program: GPA over 3.50 for Bachelor's degree
  - Ph.D programs: GPA over 3.5 for Bachelor's and GPA over 4.0 for Master's program
  - Students who fail to meet the GPA standard can still apply.

    (Those applicants will be evaluated by research performance and other extra curricular activities.)
- ► Academic performance: Grade point average of all courses acquired.(excluding F)
- Graduates from other universities(bachelor's and master's degree) must attach transcript at the time of application.

- Excellence of applicant described in the reference letter(academic performance, research performance)
- Additional point for students currently enrolled in combined Bachelor & Master program
- O Submission of Reference Letter: April. 1st (Mon.) ~ 27th (Sat.), 2019
